

## ***Cornish Ale captures the sun***

Over the summer, Penpont Brewery, working with Cornwall Rural Community Council, (CRCC) has launched a full-bodied golden ale, 'An Howl', which translated from Cornish means 'the sun'.

Penpont Brewery is a relatively new, small business set up in 2008 and is run from a converted milk parlour in Altarnun. Their reputation is going from strength to strength, with sales of Cornish ales such as the very popular 'Roughtor' and 'Cornish Arvor' expanding rapidly.

An Howl is becoming a popular choice too and is already on sale at Kingsley Village and the Bottle Bank in Falmouth and is a regular guest beer at the Blisland Inn and The Front, Falmouth, to name a few.

You will have an opportunity to sample the Ale at the Cornish Food and Drink Festival, Lemon Quay, Truro, which is being held from 24 to 26 September. It is a well rounded ale with citrus and floral hop notes and an ABV of 5.6%.
