What is LINK [Local Involvement Network] in Cornwall?

The job of LINK in Cornwall is to give you the opportunity to influence local health and social care services.

LINK is independent from the local authority and the NHS and is here to represent you.

LINK can represent you by listening to what you think are issues for health and social care services in Cornwall. Good and bad.

LINK will work with the people who plan and run these services. We will:

- * tell them what you have told us
- * ask them questions and suggest ways in which things can change for the better
- * visit some services to check out how they are run.

LINK has a statutory right to be listened to. This helps to strengthen the voice of individuals and the voluntary and community sector.

How can I make health and social care services work for me?

Join in. Be a part of LINK. You can take part as an individual or on behalf of an organisation, forum or group.

It is easy to get involved. You can be a part of LINK in a way that suits you. You can:

- * say what you think about health and social care services in Cornwall
- * come along to LINK meetings
- * be kept informed of LINK activity
- * represent LINK and join in with its activity
- * help individuals and communities in Cornwall to become a part of LINK
