Job Title: Community Engagement Tutor

Reports to: Learn Your Way Programme Manager

Responsible for: Education Support Assistants as directed

Job purpose

A pivotal role in providing tailored education and support to young adults with special educational needs, fostering their independence, and helping them achieve their goals within a supportive and inclusive learning environment.

Responsible for Community Engagement planning and delivery to young learners aged 16-24 with Special Educational Needs who possess an Education and Health Care Plan.

Coordinating and leading a practical day of learning tailored to individual learner interests, which involves community-facing activities. Also, directing and supervising Education Support Assistants (ESAs) who work with small groups of learners on that day.

Main duties and responsibilities

Community engagement coordination:

- Plan, organise, and coordinate practical days of community learning, which can be internal / external, but importantly tailored to each learner's interests
- Engage with learners to identify and select community-facing activities that meet their needs
- Ensure the safety and wellbeing of learners during practical activities
- Evaluate the effectiveness of community learning experiences and make adjustments as necessary

Education Support Assistant (ESA) supervision:

- Direct and guide ESAs in working with small groups of learners during practical days
- Provide support to ESAs to enhance their effectiveness in supporting learners with SEN

Planning and preparation:

- Two hours per week for community engagement planning
- Keep up-to-date with best practices in SEN education and adapt delivery methods accordingly
- Work alongside colleagues to share resources and strategies for improved delivery and learning outcomes

Administrative tasks:

- Maintain accurate records of learner attendance and progression
- Complete any required paperwork related to EHCPs and other documentation
- Communicate with parents/guardians and external agencies involved in the learners' support networks

Team collaboration:

- Work effectively with other teaching staff and professionals to ensure a holistic approach to learners development
- Be prepared to participate in staff meetings, training sessions, and professional development activities

Working days and hours:

- Community focused day in Truro, 9.00 am to 4.00 pm Wednesdays
- Two dedicated to planning and coordination
- Additional administrative duties as required
